Minutes of the 4 March 2026 Meeting

The meeting was held at the Forney Museum of Transportation 4303 Brighton Blvd Denver CO. Thirty-Three member-club representatives, Presidents, and guests were signed in. Officers present were Dick Thompson, President; John Ehrlich, 1st Vice President; Calvin Craig, 2nd Vice President; Nick Lundberg, Secretary; and Samantha Baker, Treasurer.

The meeting was called to order by the club President at approximately 7:31 pm.

15th Annual Corporate Pinewood Derby, Scouting Colorado: Savannah Dalton and Charlie Botnick discussed the upcoming Corporate Pinewood Derby on May 1st 1-3pm at Geotech Environmental, Denver CO. Sponsorship levels are available, car clubs are encouraged to become involved. All proceeds support Scouting programs. See attached brochure for information.

LiveJudge.com car show judging app: Michael Kranitz, affiliated with Helistorm, a non profit entity for STEM kids discussed the Livejudge.com phone app that allows real time judging for car show events and for other events that have judging needs. He is wanting to give the software to all car clubs in Colorado.

Legislation: Leo Boyle reported that Colorado House Representative Carlos Barron HD48, Ft Lupton, Minority Whip, introduced HB 26-1097 Register & Drive Surplus Military Vehicles in the 2026 Legislative Session. Unfortunately, the bill died in committee on a 4-8 committee vote. Dick Thompson of Front Range Mustang and Chris Raasch of Military Vehicle Collectors of Colorado testified in person on behalf of the bill at the Capital. Again, this bill seeks to provide a way for collectors of these vehicles to be legally owned and used. The bill will likely be introduced again next year.

Minutes of 4 February Meeting: A motion to accept, was seconded, and approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report. A summary of the financial accounts as of the end of February 2026 which were approved as published. Twenty-four clubs have renewed/joined for 2026 as of end of February 2026. Three additional club renewals for 2026 were submitted at this meeting. As it stands right now for 2026 there are twenty-seven clubs, one individual membership and one Associate membership. FYI, there were fifty member clubs, four individual memberships, and five associate memberships in 2025.

2026 CCCC Car Show and Swap Meet: For 2026, the show will be the last Saturday in July. July 25th 2026 (versus prior years it being the 1st Saturday in August) Flyers are available for distribution. Clubs please consider posting an electronic version on your club websites. Currently there are four committed food vendors. Please consider volunteering to help with the car show.

Upcoming events: Tri-State Car Show March 28th and 29th 2026. The CCCC will not have a table at the event due to no one stepping up to organize. Car Shows Inc will have a table available for RMMA car show flyers. If passing out flyers, do not put directly on show cars.

The Orphanage- An automotive Themed Gallery Space in Yuma CO, possibly will join the CCCC. Rumored that the 1942 Packard used by General Macarthur is somewhere in Colorado. The Vintage Chevy Club was disbanded at the end of 2025.
