Minutes of the 1 April 2026 Meeting

The meeting was held at the Falcon Division Police Substation 7850 Goddard St Colorado Springs. Twenty-four member-club representatives, presidents, and guests were signed in. CCCC Officers present were Dick Thompson, President; John Ehrlich, 1st Vice President; Calvin Craig, 2nd Vice President; Nick Lundberg, Secretary; the meeting was sponsored by Colorado Springs Rod & Custom.

The meeting was called to order by the club President at approximately 7:31 pm.

Legislation: Leo Boyle, our lobbyist was not in attendance, but Dick Thompson reported that Colorado Legislative session is nearing its end with about a month or so to go. The State is in a budget deficit and looking for ways to correct that. As mentioned at the last meeting, HB 26-1097 Register & Drive Surplus Military Vehicles died in committee on a 4-8 committee vote. The bill will likely be introduced again next year.

Minutes of 4 March Meeting: A motion to accept, was seconded, and approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Samantha Baker was not in attendance. A motion to approve the treasurer report as presented was moved and seconded. Thirty-Five clubs have renewed/joined for 2026 as of end of March 2026. As it stands right now for 2026 there are Thirty-Five clubs, one individual membership and three Associate memberships. FYI, there were fifty member clubs, four individual memberships, and five associate memberships in 2025.

2026 CCCC Car Show and Swap Meet: Rick Ruel was not in attendance, Dick Thompson discussed

getting sponsorships. Tom Mansfield discussed the CCCC's purpose and the importance of the car show and swap meet and discussion involved; Comes as a car club group drive in as a car club, swap meet space for clubs is \$60, Club sponsorships in the car show program for \$100, Community service volunteers. Tri State Auto Show: There were about 300 cars at the Tri State auto show in March, Samantha Baker passed out flyers for the CCCC.
