there are Forty-Two clubs, three individual membership and three Associate memberships. There are eight clubs that have not renewed as of yet for 2026. FYI, there were fifty member clubs, four individual memberships, and five associate memberships in 2025.

2026 CCCC Car Show and Swap Meet: Rick Ruel discussed status of the car show. The imperative need for volunteers from each member club. Steve Utter with the GTO club volunteered to pick-up and return tables chairs, and canopies for the show, and also the CCCC trailer from the Forney. Desired advertisements in the car show brochure are due by 7/3/26

Other discussion: John Ehrlich resigned as 2nd VP of the CCCC and Tom Mansfield was appointed as 2nd VP in his place, also Jim Merritt of the Thunderbird club has become the SEMA representative.
